KCMS Roster

Our widely-used member directory contains profile, contact and other relevant information useful for referral and communication. The Roster has a distribution of approximately 8,000 including, non-member physicians, hospitals, clinics, and other health-related organizations in King and surrounding counties.

The Bulletin

This monthly journal contains original articles, news and commentary on matters of interest to members and their office staff.

New Patient Referrals

Our popular Physician Referral Service, available to the public via telephone and the KCMS website, helps local residents find physicians throughout the county. Medical society membership can bring an extra degree of assurance when selecting a physician.

Long-Term Care Insurance
